That the waste water discharges are not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and that it cannot be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the waste water discharges, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment is required. The EPA acknowledges receipt of a Natura Impact Statement, submitted on the 20/12/2023.

This determination is based on the potential for impacts from the waste water discharges on the water dependent qualifying species at the Gearagh SAC due to the hydrological connectivity.
