I refer to correspondence of 4 December 2023, notifying the Agency of your wish to withdraw your licence application which was received by the EPA on 22 February 2023.

I advise you that the contents of your request have been noted and our records updated to reflect that this licence application is regarded as being formally withdrawn.

That being the case, it is no longer the function of the EPA to consider any documentation which relates to the above application.
