Description: Discovered in 1985 during the removal of a field boundary. Inspection by National Museum staff revealed a prehistoric grave containing cremated human bones (Kelly 1987). The walls, floor and roof of the grave were formed of small slabs and overall it measured 50cm in maximum length, 40cm in maximum width and 35cm in depth (ibid.). A preliminary examination of the bones suggested they were the remains of two adult males, one of whom may have been of advanced age (ibid.). An area of burning (diam. 1.5m, D 1m, 7m SW of the grave, was probably 'the site of the funeral pyre' (ibid.; NMI) (LI043-008002-). The stones were removed and the cist was reconstructed in Newcastle West Community Centre.

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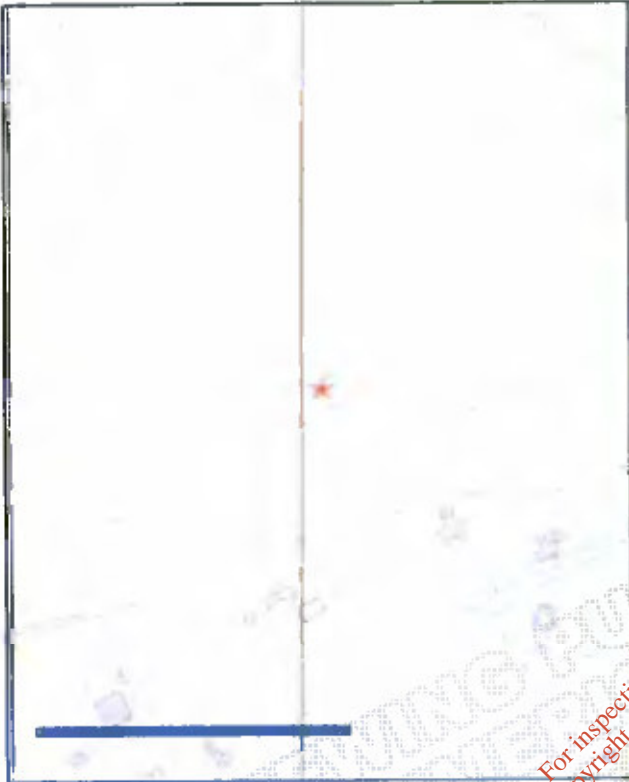

Description: In pasture, on the SSW-facing slope of a low hill. A circular area (12.3m N-S, 11.9m E-W) enclosed by a fosse (D 0.35m; With 1.95m) with an external bank (int. H 0.6m; ext. H 0.4m). The fosse is waterlogged and covered by a stand of rushes. There are opposite causewayed entrances at E (With 2.6m) and at W (With 3m). A field boundary skirts the bank at N. The interior is level and covered by rough grazing with some rushes growing on its partially waterlogged surface.

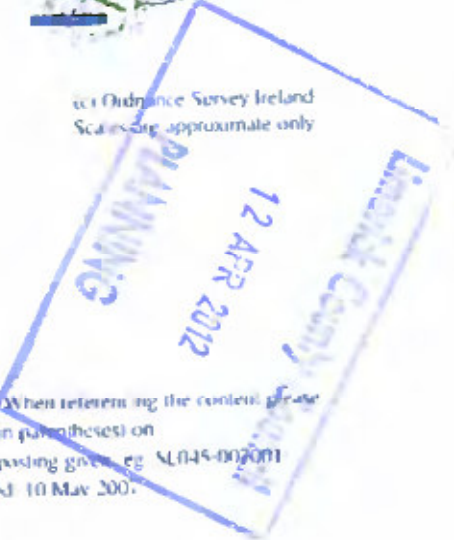

Description. On W side of river. Well, described in 1955 (O Danachair 1955, 211) as 'a hole, about two inches in diameter and three inches deep in a sloping rock surface on the edge of a little stream, could not be located. Possibly obscured by overgrowth which abounds in this area. According to O Danachair (ibid.) rounds were still occasionally made in mid-1950, and the water reputed to cure sore eyes.
