Technical Committee Report

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report. The Directors approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee subject to the following additional amendments:

A.1/Conditions Nos. 1.9.1 & 1.9.3/Scope

The Directors agreed that Condition No. 1.9.1 should be amended to read as follows: 'The installation shall may accept and dispatch waste on a twenty-four hour basis, seven days per week, 365 days a year.'

A.2 Condition No. 8.9.3/ Materials Handling

The Directors agreed that Condition No. 8.9.3 should be amended to read as follows: 'Refuse derived fuel or solid recovered fuel classified as waste shall only be supplied for combustion to an appropriate facility, except in emergencies where, with the approval subject to the agreement of the Agency, it can may be sent to other authorised waste facilities for temporary storage if authorised combustion facilities are not available.'

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Starrus Eco Holdings Limited, for their installation at Cappagh Road, Finglas, Dublin 11, Register of Licence W0261-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
