Notice in accordance with Regulation 7 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing)

Dear Sir or Madam,

I refer to your application for a licence received by the EPA on 26 April 2024.

I advise that in accordance with Regulation 7 of the EPA (IE) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended, the information required under the regulations in support of the application must be updated to reflect compliance with Regulation 7(b) as follows:

1. The Agency carried out a site notice check at the above site on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2024 and found no evidence of a site notice present at the site. Therefore, you are required to submit photographic evidence of the required site notice erected on site.

The EPA therefore requires you to *republish the site notice* referring to the 'Newspaper Notice - Guidance for Applicants' and 'Site Notice - Guidance for Applicants' documents on the EPA website.

Please submit the following evidence that you have complied with the regulations:

- 1. An extract of the revised site notice erected on site;
- 2. Photographic evidence of the revised site notice erected on site.

The requested information should be submitted to the EPA within 28 Calendar Days of the date of this notice in order to allow the EPA to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the EPA is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with.
