The EPA granted a revised licence, subject to conditions on the 16 May 2024 to Starrus Eco Holdings Limited, Panda Waste Management Solutions, Ballymount Road Upper, Dublin 24. IE Reg. No. W0261-03, for Classes 11.1 & 11.4(b)(ii): The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, and the recovery, or a mix of recovery and disposal, of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes per day involving one or more of the following activities: pre-treatment of waste for incineration or co-incineration, for an installation located at Cappagh Road, Finglas, Dublin 11. A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for Judicial Review and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 87(10) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision.
