RE: Further Notice under the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence review from Mr Michael Monagle for an installation located Annakisha North, Doneraile, County Cork, P51 EY43.

Dear Philip,

NRGE on behalf of Michael Monagle of Annakisha North (P0446-01) herein provide the information requested by the agency on the 17th of May 2024 in relation to the EPA's notice requesting information on the 16th of November 2023/ the licence review submitted on the 17th of May 2023.

1. The submitted NIS does not address all of the European sites listed in the AA Screening Determination, issued by the Agency on 15 November 2023, which identified that these sites may be negatively impacted by emissions to air of ammonia (and associated nitrogen deposition) from the installation. Update the NIS accordingly.
