Clerical or Technical Amendment Application Details

Proposed Alteration Description

Packaging Laundry Limited is seeking to amend the red-line licence boundary to facilitate the indoor storage of refurbished, ready for re-use, IBC containers in a newly acquired property that adjoins the existing facility. This will negate the requirement to store containers outdoors and will alleviate current space restrictions.

There will be no processing within the extended area (the space is required for temporary storage, pending collection), no new waste types are proposed and no new emission points will arise.

Condition 1.3 of the Licence refers to the current licensed area. It is proposed to amend this to reflect the extended area (see attached figure). The proposed alteration will not have an adverse impacts on human health or the environment but will facilitate more orderly temporary storage of clean containers.

The proposed boundary extension will not impact upon protected sites and AA Screening exercise associated with the application for W0304-01 remains valid.
