The EPA granted a revised licence, subject to conditions on the 27th March 2025, to Roadstone Limited, Fortunestown, Tallaght, Dublin 24, Waste Reg. No. W0277-04 for activities: R03- Recycling/ reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes), which includes gasification and pyrolysis using the components as chemicals, R05-Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials, which includes soil cleaning resulting in recovery of the soil and recycling of inorganic construction materials and, R13- Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced) of the Waste Management Act for a facility located at Huntstown Quarry, Huntstown, Kilshane and Johnstown Townlands, Finglas, Dublin 11. A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for Judicial Review and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 43(5)(b)(i) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision.
