**Application To The Environmental Protection Agency For A Review Of A Licence**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the E.P.A. Act 1992, as amended, that Mr. Declan Sullivan, Drumcreeghan, Latton, Castleblayney, Co. Monaghan intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.) for a review of a Licence for their poultry farm at Drumcreeghan, Latton, Castleblayney, Co. Monaghan. This enterprise is classed as: Activity Class 6.1 (a) "The rearing of poultry in installations where the capacity exceeds 40,000 places." An Environmental Impact Assessment Report relating to this activity, which has previously been submitted to Monaghan County Council, will be submitted to the Agency as part of this application.
