SCHEDULE TO PLANNING PERMISSION NO. 1238/93

SUBJECT TO 4 NO. CONDITIONS.

 All existing roadside trees and hedgerows not affected by the proposed entrance shall be retained.

Reason - In the interests of amenity.

All roof water shall be discharged uncontaminated to its own independent drainage system.

Reason - To prevent pollution.

3. The poultry litter shall not be spread within 100 metres of any house without the written permission of the owner/occupier thereof. No poultry litter shall be spread within 100 metres of any source of potable water supply, or within 50 metres of any watercourse. No spreading shall be carried out during periods of drought, high rainfall, high water table levels, or frozen ground conditions.

Reason - To prevent nuisance and pollution.

4. The rate of spreading of poultry litter shall not exceed 4 tonnes per acre per annum over the 100 acres available and excess waste shall be removed for disposal off the site in a manner to be agreed with the Planning Authority before production commences.

Reason - To control the spreading of litter and in the interests of public health.
